NGOs must be invested in integrating a sustainable energy vertical to their existing work. For example, NGOs working in livelihood can think on adding accessible sustainable energy to augment the impact of their livelihood projects.

What does the platform offer?

The collaborative platform will allow for a partnerships and mentoring. Joint design and execution of pilots will be conducted, along with field visits of existing SELCO implementation sites to gain first-hand experience. If selected, SELCO will also provide seed funding to kick off sustainable energy projects with the NGO-in-Residence.
